



Guest Information Sheet

Greetings guests! We would like to offer you a warm, southern welcome to the home club of Bobby Jones, the Atlanta Athletic Club. The AAC has a wonderful history of Major Championship golf having been the host site of the 1976 U.S. Open Championship; 1981, 2001, and 2011 PGA Championships; the 1990 U.S. Women's Open; and most recently, the 2021 Women's PGA Championship. Future events include the 2025 U.S. Girls' Junior, 2030 U.S. Amateur, and 2035 U.S. Women's Amateur. We hope that you thoroughly enjoy your visit to our historic club and take part in our rich traditions and culture during your time here.

As a guest of the club, we kindly ask that you abide by the following club rules to ensure a pleasurable golfing experience:

- Upon arrival, please utilize the locker room to change your shoes and clothes. Please do not change in the parking lot. Guest lockers are available.
- The use of cell phones is permitted, but audible alerts must be turned off at all times. Cell phone calls may be taken in the locker rooms, main entrance hallway, and the parking lot.
- The expected pace of play for 18 holes is 4 hours or less. (If you play well, play fast... if you play poorly, play faster)
- Please remember to repair ball marks, rake bunkers and fill in divots with sand.
- Gentlemen are expected to remove their hats upon entering the clubhouse.
- Appropriate golf attire:
 - **Gentlemen:** Collared shirts are required and shirts must remain tucked in at all times. Only golf slacks or appropriate-length golf shorts are allowed, cargo shorts are not permitted. Hats must be worn with the bill facing forward.
 - **Ladies:** Golf shorts or skirts must be of an appropriate length. Acceptable shirts include short sleeve and sleeveless collared shirts, and collarless tops with sleeves. Ladies may wear their tops untucked.
- Caddies are required for unaccompanied groups; the caddie rate for the entire group is \$120 for a group with one or two players. The fee for the group is \$200 for a group with more than two players. Caddie fees are paid in cash. This fee includes gratuity.
- Purchases can be made in the golf shop and the halfway house using cash or credit card.
